The Board of Directors of the Humboldt Community Services District met in Regular Session at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 28, 2023, in person and via tele/video conference in accordance with AB 361 and HCSD Resolution 2023-02.

 - Scada Backup Solar After the December earthquake, the highest priority item identified to improve emergency response is that of reliable automatic backup power for the District's critical remote SCADA terminals. GM is building a prototype system for initial testing at the Cummings Road Tank. Once determined reliable, similar systems will be deployed to each of the approximate 40 critical stations without automatic backup power. The result will enable staff to respond to stations in need of attention rather than driving from station to station checking the status during extended, District wide power outages.

- District Tour Directors Gardiner and Matteoli joined the GM and District Superintendent on February 17 for a 4.5-hour tour of District facilities. Directors Benzonelli, Ryan, and Hansen's tours will be scheduled for a date in the future.

SUBJECT: General Manager Report for March 14, 2023 Board Meeting

McKay Ranch Subdivision

The McKay Ranch Subdivision is back in the news because, on March 7, 2023, the Board of Supervisors approved a development agreement between the County and Kramer Properties, Inc., the project proponent. The proposed subdivision is approximately 81 acres and includes 320 residential units and 22,000 square feet of commercial space. The proposed subdivision is adjacent to the District and will need to be annexed into the District so that water and wastewater services can be provided.

On January 26, 2021 the District Board of Directors approved a mitigation measure for inclusion into the County's Environmental Impact Report for the Project. The mitigation measure is intended to ensure that there is sufficient water supply for fire suppression within and outside of the proposed subdivision. The mitigation measure includes construction of 250,000 gallons of additional water storage at the Ridgewood Tank Site (which serves Cutten) as well as upsizing a section of pipe along Walnut Drive between Holly and Cypress to 12 inches diameter.

On March 1, 2022 (just over a year ago), District staff met with staff from Kramer Properties, Inc., and staff from Humboldt LAFCo to discuss annexation of the property where the subdivision is proposed. The process of annexation was discussed along with costs and document requirements. The cost of application must be borne by the project proponent but the application for annexation must come from the annexing agency (HCSD). The next steps identified during that meeting were that the project proponent will supply a legal description of the property to be annexed and a deposit to cover the annexation costs (\$5,000) to the District. The ball is currently in the project proponent's court as we have not yet received a deposit or a legal description of the property to be annexed.

Finally, the project proponent will need to enter into a water and sewer mainline extension agreement with the District. The agreement will require the project proponent to construct, to District standards, the necessary water and sewer infrastructure within the subdivision and upgrade inadequate infrastructure that serves the subdivision, outside of the subdivision. Once the infrastructure is constructed, ownership will be turned over to the District for operation and maintenance.

On March 8, 2023, John Ford, Director of Planning for the County of Humboldt reached out to District staff to discuss the McKay Ranch Subdivision. He asked about the mitigation measure, the annexation process and the mainline extension agreement. We also discussed potential funding for the mitigation measure. Staff was able to answer all of his questions to his satisfaction. In fact, when the call was ended, he said, "I love it when things are easy."

General Manager's Report to the Board of Directors for March 14, 2023 Board Meeting

State of Emergency

On March 8, 2023, Governor Newsom proclaimed a state of emergency to support storm response and relief efforts in 21 counties including Humboldt. This was in addition to the 13 counties under a state of emergency proclamation from a week prior. Although the storms and severe weather have impacted all of our lives, the District has not sustained any significant damage as a result. Considerable rain and some wind is predicated for our area over the next week so we will continue to stay vigilant.

Earthquake Recovery

District staff has initiated an application to CalOES for Disaster Recovery Funds for damage caused by the earthquake in December 2022. The application is for costs associated with protection measures performed immediately after the earthquake and for necessary repair work within Walnut Drive. CalOES requires an Authorized Agent Resolution to complete the application process. The resolution is included on the current agenda.

District Tour

A District facilities tour is scheduled for Directors Benzonelli and Ryan for Friday March 24, 2023. Once that tour is complete a final tour will be scheduled for Director Hansen with room for one other director as desired.

Additionally, City management has extended the offer to tour the Wastewater Treatment Facility, as was previously extended by Director Hansen. Tours of the Wastewater Treatment Facility will be facilitated by the City's Utility Operations Supervisor, Abe Crow. Please let me know if any of you are interested in a tour of the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant and I will help coordinate.

Hemlock Sewer Reversal

The Hemlock Sewer Reversal Project is intended to take Cutten's wastewater flow off of the City's Cross-Town Interceptor and direct it instead to the Martin Slough Interceptor through the City's O Street Station. Design documents are approaching final draft status. The project will connect the North Cutten neighborhood to the Martin Slough Interceptor by means of a 4,300 foot gravity sewer main. Approximately 70% of the gravity line will utilize a City of Eureka abandoned pressure sewer force main. This existing line has been inspected by the District, and found to be in mostly good condition, and sloped appropriately for gravity service. Approximately 1800 feet of the existing line which does not require rehabilitation is represented by the red line in Figure 1. The project includes installation of approximately 1200 feet of new gravity sewer main (green line), rehabilitation of approximately 1300 feet of the existing main (orange line), and installation of 11 new gravity manholes (green dots), as shown in Figure 1.



Figure 1: A depiction of the Hemlock Sewer Reversal project extending from the intersection of Walnut and Hemlock (green flag) to the O Street station on the Martin Slough Interceptor (checker flag).

Paving Projects The District

The District has solicited quotes from local contractors for three separate roadway resurfacing projects following the completion of water main replacement projects on Christian Lane, Tower Drive, and two water main ruptures on Park Street. The total value of these projects falls well below the \$200,000 CUPCCAA threshold for informal bidding.

Recommendation:

Motion to adopt Resolution 2023-04 designating the District's General Manager, Superintendent and Finance Manager by titles only as authorized agents to execute all assurances and agreements with the CalOES related to all open and future Disasters Relief and Hazard Mitigation Grants for up to 3 years from the date of adoption.

Summary:

In 2018, the District submitted an application for grant consideration under the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program that is administered by CalOES related to replacing/updating the 14" AC pipe from the South Broadway Pump Station to the Elk River Wastewater Treatment Plant. The project has been funded and is in process.

In 2022, the District applied for Hazard Mitigation Funding for several projects including a sea level rise/flood hardening project at the Hoover Lift Station, permanent standby generators for the Pine Hill, Artino, and Bailey Lift Stations and a forcemain realignment/hardening project for Fields Landing.

Recently, the District has applied for Disaster Relief Funds related to damage caused by the December 20, 2022 Earthquake. The State has authorized relief funds under the associated State of Emergency.

The District's active CalOES' Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies will expire in April. In order for staff to continue the application and administration processes, it is necessary to update the authorization. The attached Resolution 2023-04 serves to update the District's records with CalOES.

Upon passing this resolution, the Board Secretary will certify the Board action and submit the resolution with a cover letter identifying the current authorized agents (Terrence Williams, Tim Latham and Michael Montag) by name and title.

Cal OES Form 130 Instructions

A Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies is required of all Applicants to be eligible to receive funding. A new resolution must be submitted if a previously submitted resolution is older than three (3) years from the last date of approval, is invalid, or has not been submitted.

When completing the Cal OES Form 130, Applicants should fill in the blanks on pages 1 and 2. The blanks are to be filled in as follows:

Resolution Section:

Governing Body: This is the group responsible for appointing and approving the Authorized Agents.

Examples include: Board of Directors, City Council, Board of Supervisors, Board of Education, etc.

Name of Applicant: The public entity established under the laws of the State of California.

Examples include: School District, Office of Education, City, County or Non-profit agency that has applied for the grant, such as: City of San Diego, Sacramento County, Burbank Unified School District, Napa County Office of Education, University Southern California.

Authorized Agent: These are the individuals that are authorized by the Governing Body to engage with the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services regarding grants for which they have applied. There are two ways of completing this section:

- Titles Only: The titles of the Authorized Agents should be entered here, not their names. This allows the document to remain valid if an Authorized Agent leaves the position and is replaced by another individual. If "Titles Only" is the chosen method, this document must be accompanied by either a cover letter naming the Authorized Agents by name and title, or the Cal OES AA Names document. The supporting document can be completed by any authorized person within the Agency (e.g., administrative assistant, the Authorized Agent, secretary to the Director). It does not require the Governing Body's signature.
- 2. Names and Titles: If the Governing Body so chooses, the names **and** titles of the Authorized Agents would be listed. A new Cal OES Form 130 will be required if any of the Authorized Agents are replaced, leave the position listed on the document, or their title changes.



Checking Universal or Disaster-Specific Box: A Universal resolution is effective for all past disasters and for those declared up to three (3) years following the date of approval. Upon expiration it is no longer effective for new disasters, but it remains in effect for disasters declared prior to expiration. It remains effective until the disaster goes through closeout unless it is superseded by a newer resolution.

Governing Body Representative: These are the names and titles of the approving Board Members.

Examples include: Chairman of the Board, Director, Superintendent, etc. The names and titles **cannot** be one of the designated Authorized Agents. A minimum of three (3) approving board members must be listed. If less than three are present, meeting minutes must be attached in order to verify a quorum was met.

Certification Section:

Name and Title: This is the individual in attendance who recorded the creation and approval of this resolution.

Examples include: City Clerk, Secretary to the Board of Directors, County Clerk, etc. This person **cannot** be one of the designated Authorized Agents or Approving Board Member. If a person holds two positions (such as City Manager and Secretary to the Board) and the City Manager is to be listed as an Authorized Agent, then that person could sign the document as Secretary to the Board (not City Manager) to eliminate "Self-Certification."
