False statements by an applicant shall result in full sewer service charges being levied for the entire period of claimed vacancy, and shall also be cause to refuse a request for waiver of sewer service charge for a period of two-years for any property owned or in possession of the applicant.

7.04.020 Waiver of Sewer Service Charges. If a living unit is separately metered for water consumption and is to be totally unoccupied for a period of at least 30 days by reason of an extended vacation period or a vacancy, the sewer charge may be waived for that living unit for such period if: a.) The owner or lessee or operator of the unit notifies the District of the vacancy by filing a sworn application with the District no later than 10 days after the commencement of the period of vacancy; b.) The Manager of the District determines that the sewer will not be used for such period; and c.) There is no water consumption in said living unit for said period. The applicant shall immediately notify the District when such living unit next becomes occupied. False statements by an applicant shall result in full sewer charges being levied for the entire period of claimed vacancy, and shall also be cause to refuse a request for waiver of service charges for a period of two years as to any property owned or in possession of the applicant.
